PART 2 - "HOW TO HUMBLY SERVE"
Matthew 10:5-15

⁵Jesus sent the twelve disciples out with these instructions: ⁶Don't go to the Gentiles or the Samaritans, ⁶but only to the people of Israel – God's lost sheep. ⁷Go and announce to them that the Kingdom of Heaven is near. ⁸Heal the sick, raise the dead, cure those with leprosy, and cast out demons. Give as freely as you have received! ⁹Don't take any money with you. ¹⁰Don't carry a traveler's bag with an extra coat and sandals or even a walking stick. Don't hesitate to accept hospitality, because those who work deserve to be fed. ¹¹Whenever you enter a city or village, search for a worthy man and stay in his home until you leave for the next town. ¹²When you are invited into someone's home, give it your blessing. ¹³If it turns out to be a worthy home, let your blessing stand; if it is not, take back the blessing. ¹⁴If a village doesn't welcome you or listen to you, shake off the dust of that place from your feet as you leave. ¹⁵I assure you, the wicked cities of Sodom and Gomorrah will be better off on the judgment day than that place will be.

You have been chosen to advance God's rule and reign (His Kingdom) by humbly serving Him.
To do so you need to know:

I. **Where** you **go** to **influence** people for Jesus.
Matthew 10:5-6a

II. **What** you're to **do** to **reach** people for Jesus.
Matthew 10:7-8a

III. **How** you're to be **towards** people.
Matthew 10:8b-10

IV. **Who** you're to **touch** with the Good News of Jesus.
Matthew 10:11-13a

V. **How** to **respond** to **rejection**.
Matthew 10:13b-15
